SIGNATURE DESIGN BLENDS WITH SURROUNDINGS

Projects for the City of Southlake, Texas

As part of a relationship that extends back to the first composite elevated tank built in the U.S., Landmark's third and fourth tanks for the City of Southlake, Texas demonstrate a unique design that reflects community identity and pride. While the architectural treatment of the concrete pedestal is a standard feature of all Landmark projects, city leaders wanted to add a distinctive treatment to the steel tank, utilizing a color and design pattern that extends to other municipal infrastructure as well. Landmark collaborated on the design and executed all aspects of construction, utilizing the capabilities of their steel fabrication operations. In addition, the most recent 1.5 million gallon tank incorporates a piping and controls room and storage floors inside the pedestal, as well as integrated cellular antenna systems.



The result in both cases: Structures that make a strong aesthetic statement while also integrating seamlessly with their surroundings.
